CONDITIONS

- Neither conference organizers nor anyone who has received a Trust bursary or grant in the past three years is eligible to apply.
- In October 2010, the names of 30 (or more) recipients will be drawn from the list of qualified applicants. The names of the successful applicants will be posted on the Trust webpage. School jurisdictions, ATA local associations and specialist councils will be notified.
- The successful applicants will receive a claim form to be submitted to the Trust after they attend the conference. **Original receipts totalling at least \$300 for expenses that were not reimbursed by other groups** must be attached to the claim form.
