Eligibility

Teacher means a person holding a permanent or temporary certificate of qualification as a teacher issued by the minister under the *Department of Education Act*.

Eligibility for associate membership is available to any person, other than a person eligible for active membership, as follows:

- (a) superintendents of schools employed by school boards;
- (b) teachers employed by the Government of Alberta;
- (c) members of the faculties of education of the universities in Alberta;
- (d) teachers employed as faculty members in public colleges;
- (e) teachers engaged in teacher education in private colleges affiliated with any of the universities in Alberta;
- (f) teachers in private schools or kindergartens;
- (g) teachers in schools within the province operated by the Government of Canada;
- (h) teachers employed by the Association or any of its local associations;
- (i) unemployed teachers;
- (j) teachers pursuing further studies on a full-time basis;
- (k) retired teachers;
- (l) teachers employed in community education programs operated by agencies other than school boards;
- (m) teachers employed by the Alberta Teachers' Retirement Fund Board;

- (n) teachers employed by charter schools;
- (o) Elders, Knowledge Keepers and Cultural Advisors and non-certificated educators employed by First Nations School Authorities;
- (p) persons not eligible for active membership employed by school boards such as social workers, psychologists, therapists or clinicians;
- (q) other persons or classes of persons that the Provincial Executive Council may designate, from time to time, subject to the ratification of the Annual Representative Assembly.

Note: Substitute teachers are considered active members from the date on which they first actually teach until the end of the school year or until they are no longer on the approved substitute roster of a school board, whichever occurs first.
